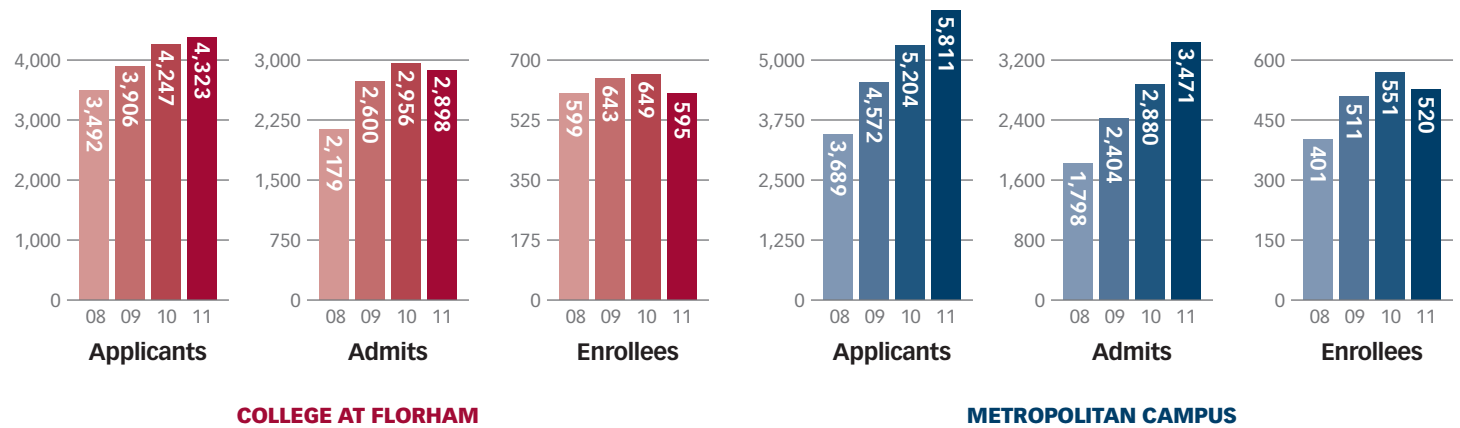

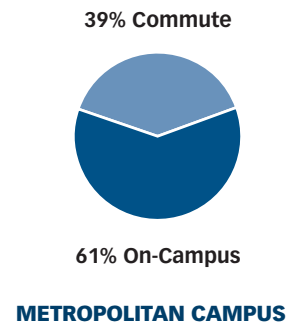
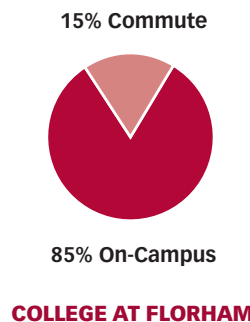
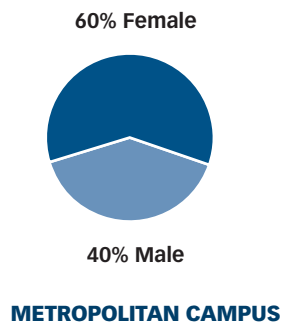
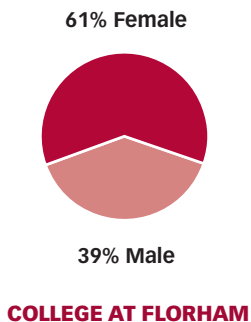


From Applicants to Enrollees

2011 Entering Freshman Class Profile by Campus



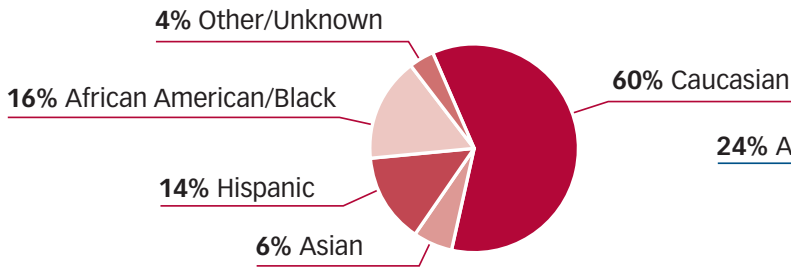

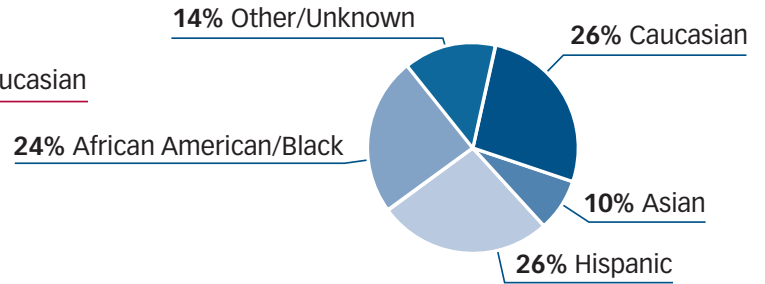
The University's international locations include **Wroxton College** in Banbury, England, and **FDU-Vancouver** in British Columbia, Canada.

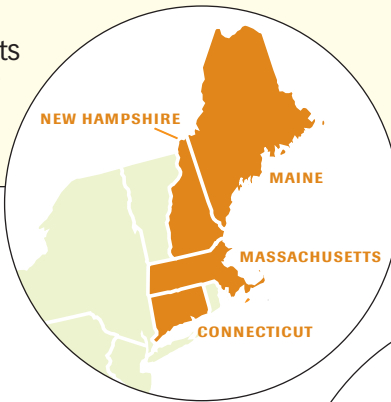

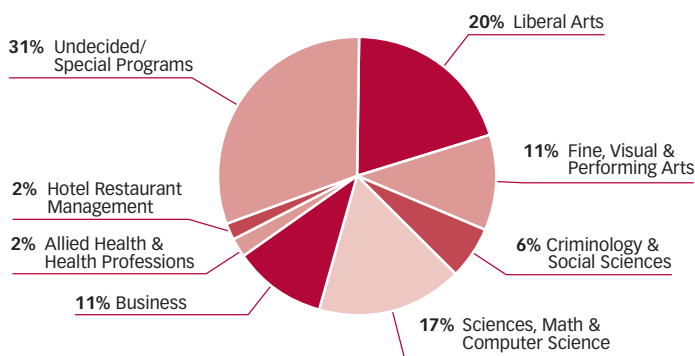

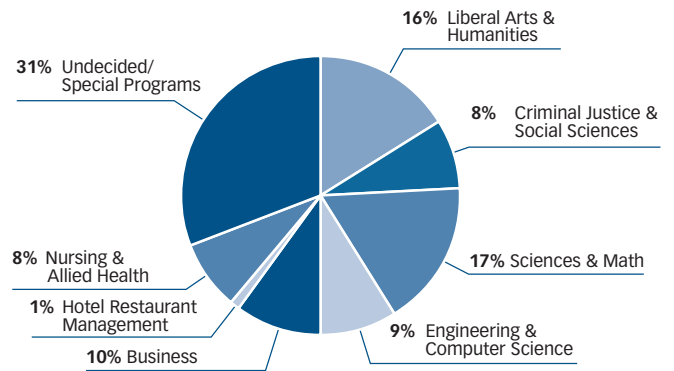
