

» Course Enrollment

FDU advisor will confirm availability. Students complete a course request form in advance.

Note: Some academic areas may have restricted enrollment.

» Course Load

Minimum of 12 credits and maximum of 18 credits permitted for undergraduate. Minimum of 9 credits for postgraduate. Online course permission must be confirmed.

» Exams and Learning Expectations

Depends on each course instructor.

» How Will Transcripts Be Sent to the Partner/Home university?

Student must request the Office of Records to report the official transcript and provide mailing details.

» Is Housing Provided by Fairleigh Dickinson University in New Jersey?

On-campus housing is available.

- » Approximate Cost of Accommodation Per Semester \$7,550 including meals
- » Academic Expenses

Approximately \$500 for books and supplies

Meals included in on-campus housing cost.

» Health Insurance Requirements

Exchange students must purchase the FDU UnitedHealthcare medical insurance plan. Costs for 2021/2022 for Graduate \$3,808 (full year) or \$1,449 (Fall only) and \$2,359 (Spring semester). For undergraduate \$1,834(full year) or \$697 (Fall only) and \$1,137(Spring semester)
