Eligibility for all Executive Board Member candidates includes (in addition to requirements listed for each position):

- 1) A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 at time of application.
- 2) Must currently reside in the residence halls.
- 3) Must reside in the residence halls during their entire term in office.
- 4) If elected, candidate is required to serve in position for the entire academic year (Fall & Spring).
- 5) Must currently be registered and enrolled in at least 12 credits at Fairleigh Dickinson University.
- 6) Must not be subject to any administrative or disciplinary sanctions, the terms of which preclude participation in University activities.

President

- 1) Any undergraduate student who has a minimum of 36 credits completed.
- 2) Candidates will not be able to serve in any other presidential or vice-presidential positions for the Student Government Association, Student Programming Board, or the Commuter Council.
- 3) Candidates will not be able to serve as a Resident Assistant in Housing & Residence Life.
- 4) Must have served on RHA Executive Board for at least one term.

Vice-President

- 1) Any undergraduate student who has a minimum of 12 credits completed.
- 2) Candidates will not be able to serve in any other presidential or vice-presidential positions for the Student Government Association, Student Programming Board, or the Commuter Council.

Treasurer

- 1) Any undergraduate student who has a minimum of 12 credits completed.

Secretary

- 1) Any undergraduate student who has a minimum of 12 credits completed.

Events Chair

- 1) Any undergraduate student who has a minimum of 12 credits completed.

Public Relations

- 1) Any undergraduate student who has a minimum of 12 credits completed.
