
#### Note from UnitedHealthcare about Receiving Adult Vaccines

While we strive to make our benefits easy to understand, there are some issues that arise from time to time. I would like to take a proactive approach and advise you of issues that come up that I feel may need clarification to help you and your employees.

One such item is the Shingles Vaccine. This vaccine is a covered preventive care service for members **age 60 and over**. Members should be able to receive the shot from an in-network physician. However, many physicians do not store it because it does not keep long. If you have a member whose provider informs them they do not have the vaccine, please be advised that the drug can be ordered through our Specialty pharmacy program for delivery directly to either the member's home or provider's office so the member can go in to receive it. The provider can call Prescription Solutions at 888-739-5820 to fax in a script for the member. If the member has not previously registered with the Specialty Pharmacy program, either he or the provider can do so by calling the Specialty Pharmacy Referral Line at 1-866-429-8177.
