

What If I Fall Below a 2.0 GPA?



- The first time an undergraduate student's GPA falls below a 2.0, the student will be placed on Academic Probation. You will also be placed on a restriction of credits.
- This is the time to reflect on your career goals and decide on the course of action that will serve you best in the future. The University suggests the student meets with an academic advisor to plan an appropriate action to improve this status.

If You Are On Academic Probation... Get Help Right Away!!!



- Students who have been on probation who continue to make less than satisfactory progress toward their degrees will be suspended from the University.
- A suspended student may apply for readmission to the University after one semester.
- Students who are readmitted after being suspended are considered to be on probation and must meet specific academic objectives.
- ❖ Failure to meet those objectives will result in DISMISSAL from the University.
