FLEXIBLE COURSE DELIVERY

You can choose online, blended or in-person classes at FDU-approved sites in the Teaneck, N.J., area.

SPECIALLY PRICED TUITION

As an expression of FDU's commitment to affordable access, FDU's Yeshiva Program costs 50% less than our standard tuition. In addition, financial aid is available from federal and state grants and loans to qualifying students. Our Financial Aid Office can help you successfully navigate the financial aid process.

GENEROUS TRANSFER CREDITS

You can transfer up to 90 credits earned outside of FDU, allowing you to complete your degree in as little as one year. Credit sources can include:

- Up to 72 credits from prior yeshiva study
- Credits from AP, CLEP or other exams, and credits earned at other colleges

You'll benefit from personal support throughout your time in the Yeshiva Program. Each semester, your Yeshiva counselor will work closely with you to customize your course load so it matches your goals. In addition, academic assistance is available in the form of in-person and online tutoring.
