ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Launch a new career. Start your own company. Or continue your education at a top graduate or professional school. As a student in FDU's Yeshiva program for men or Seminary program for women, you'll complete your **Bachelor of Arts in Individualized Studies** and achieve career success through exceptional academics, supportive professors and affordable tuition.

Designed for busy students in the Orthodox Jewish community, both programs offer the advantages of shorter terms as well as in-person and online courses. You'll study with other members of the Orthodox Jewish faith and join a caring and supportive University community focused on your unique needs and goals.

In addition, we will accept up to 90 credits earned outside of FDU to allow you to complete your degree in as little as one year.

Credit sources can include:

- Up to 72 credits from prior yeshiva and seminary study
- Credits from AP, CLEP or other exams, and credits earned at other colleges

SPECIALLY PRICED TUITION

As an expression of FDU's commitment to affordable access for all students, the Yeshiva and Seminary Programs cost 50% less than our standard tuition. In addition, financial aid is available from federal and state grants and loans to qualifying students. Our Financial Aid Office can help you successfully navigate the financial aid process.

A STRONG SUPPORT NETWORK

Each semester, you'll work closely with your Yeshiva or Seminary counselor to customize a course load that matches your goals. In addition, academic assistance is available in the form of in-person and online tutoring.

BEYOND YOUR BACHELOR'S

Upon completion of your degree, FDU invites you to consider graduate studies in one of our 60-plus graduate programs at regular tuition rates. You can learn more at fdu.edu/grad.

These include professional programs within our School of Pharmacy & Health Sciences. Degrees include Entry-Level Occupational Therapy Doctorate and Physician Assistant (on-campus), or Master of Public Health and Master of Social Work (all-online).

SPECIALIZATIONS

You can tailor your education by choosing a specialization. Options include business, psychology, entrepreneurship, public health administration, technology management, health sciences and general education. A specialization requires the completion of 18 credits in that discipline.

- Completed application (fdu.edu/jewishprograms and click APPLY NOW!)
- Proof of a high school diploma (official transcript) or GED
- Official transcripts from all previously attended colleges, yeshivas or seminaries

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of 120 credits (at least 30 at FDU)
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0 in upper-level courses completed at FDU
- Completion of 18 credits in chosen specialization
