Frequently Asked Questions

Should I apply for the EOF Program?

To be considered, applicants must be first-time, full-time freshmen and residents of New Jersey for a minimum of one year prior to attendance. Students must also meet state income eligibility guidelines. For more information, visit fdu.edu/eof.
