



What the ASC Does

Free tutoring support for over 40 subjects

Workshops

Walk-in Wednesdays Help with time management and study skills

Who Helps Students at the ASC

Professional tutors

- They bring course-specific knowledge to their appointments
- As FDU professors and staff members, they provide students with information on key FDU resources

Peer tutors

- FDU faculty recommend our peer tutors
- Peer tutors earn a B+ or higher in courses they support
- Peer tutors provide insider knowledge, often having had the same courses/professors
