Impact on Learning and Teacher Effectiveness

CAEP Measure 1: The vast majority of teachers in the state did not receive a summative rating for the 2019-2020 school year due to the circumstances related to COVID-19 public health emergency. Therefore, this data is not being reported. This impact and effectiveness data comes from the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) Education Preparation Provider Annual Report, released summer 2021. This data is for FDU program completers who graduated during the 2017-18 school year who were employed in NJ public schools during the 2018-19 school year. Of the FDU program completers who were evaluated,

Evaluation Score Type	% Scoring Effective or Highly Effective
Summative Score: based on multiple measures of student achievement and teacher practice. This varies by grade and subject taught	94%
Teacher Practice Score: measured through classroom observations and pre/post-conferences	90%
Student Growth Objective Score: combined score as assessed by the district's evaluation system for assigning teacher performance ratings	86%

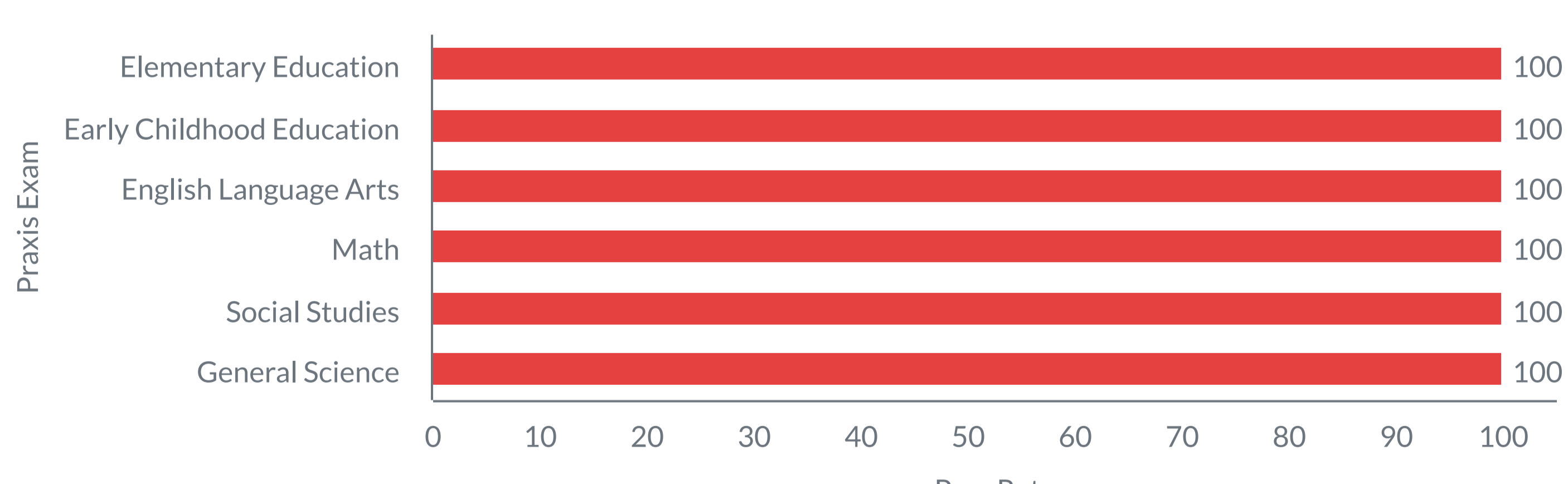
