



VERIFICATION OF 2021 IRS INCOME TAX RETURN INFORMATION FOR STUDENT/SPOUSE TAX FILERS

How to verify tax information:

The best way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) that is part of FAFSA on the Web at FAFSA.gov. The DRT links income information directly from the IRS to the student's FAFSA. If the DRT is used no further documentation is needed to verify income tax return information in most cases.

If you are unable or choose not to use the IRS DRT, you can submit your 2021 Tax Return Transcript or a SIGNED copy of your 2021 income tax return and applicable schedules to the Office of Financial Aid. **Only send pages 1 and 2 of the 1040 form and schedules 1, 2 and 3 if the tax filer was required to submit those forms.**

If the student is married and the student's spouse filed separate 2021 IRS income tax returns, provide the returns for both the student and the student's spouse.

Notify the financial aid office if the student/spouse had a change in marital status after December 31, 2021.

How to submit documents:

DO NOT EMAIL copies of your tax returns to the Office of Financial Aid.
