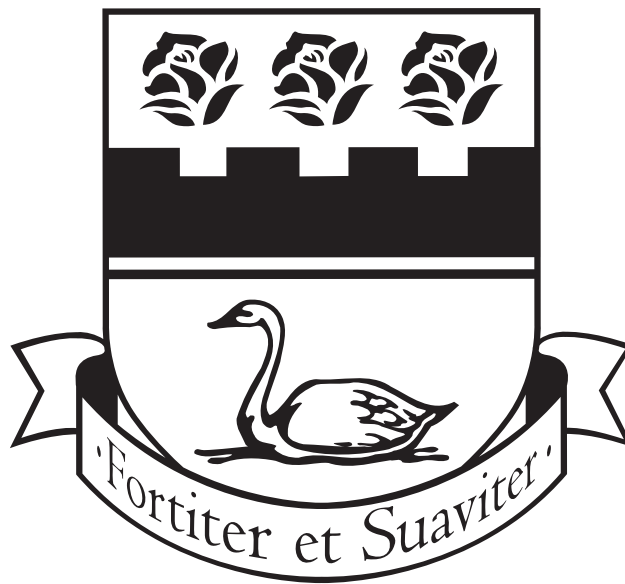

Only weighted grades will be included in computing honors. Only the credits taken at Fairleigh Dickinson University, a minimum of 54 credits, will be used in this evaluation.

Due to time constraints, the honors listed therein were determined as of the end of the fall semester. The final listing for the commencement period will include those honors earned as of the completion of the spring semester, and diplomas will reflect this achievement.

Sarita E. Brown

Co-founder and President, Excelencia in Education

Sarita E. Brown was born in Washington Heights, N.Y., and grew up in San Antonio, Texas. She earned bachelor's degrees in communications and ethnic studies and a master's degree in communications from the University of Texas at Austin. At the time, UT Austin had few African American and Mexican American students, which led Brown to question this inequity. After graduating, she was hired by her alma mater. During her 15 years there, she built a national model for increasing the number of students of color earning doctoral degrees. This pioneering work marked the beginning of her dedicated efforts to identify and implement higher-education opportunities for Latinos and other underserved student groups.

Brown later moved to Washington, D.C., where she worked at several prominent national educational institutions and high-level government institutions, for which she implemented strategies designed to raise achievement and create opportunities for low-income and minority students.

Her work led to her appointment in 1997 as executive director of the White House Initiative on Educational Excellence for Hispanic Americans. In that role, she was credited with revitalizing the Initiative's mission, as well as renewing the focus on funding for effective programs that reached and served Hispanics.

Brown is recognized as a tireless advocate for educational equity and a national leader for action to catalyze and support higher-education leaders to serve post-traditional students. Her leadership and contributions have garnered her many honors, including as a recipient of the Medal of Service from Columbia University's Teachers College and the Harry S. Truman Award from the American Association of Community Colleges. She accepted the prestigious Harold G. McGraw Jr. Prize in Education for *Excelencia's* "innovative thinking, strong leadership and accomplishment by example."

Excelencia in Education is a continuation of her passion for developing and promoting educational opportunities for Latino students and guiding them to success. "Our work makes it much easier for institutions who are finally ready to grow their Latino enrollments and do all they can to help them graduate," she says. "Our work will help close the gaps and benefit a whole new generation of college-goers."

Deborah A. Santiago

*Co-founder and Chief Operating Officer,
Excelecencia in Education*

Deborah A. Santiago grew up in a military family. When her father received an overseas assignment, her parents, both Puerto Rican, encouraged her to stay in the United States to finish high school and attend college. As the first member of her family to pursue a college education, Santiago realized she had no idea how to navigate the college-search process. She reached out to teachers and friends for advice as she researched schools, applied for financial aid, filled out applications and set up college interviews. That experience was a catalyst for a career dedicated to supporting other underserved students aiming for higher education.

Santiago went on to earn a bachelor's degree in economics from the University of Mary Washington and a master's degree in urban studies and public policy from Virginia Tech. After working for several years with educational and awareness organizations, she applied to the prestigious and highly competitive Presidential Management Fellows Program. As a fellow, Santiago served as a program analyst with the U.S. Department of Education, working on policy, budget and legislative projects. She furthered her expertise on legislative issues in higher education at the Library of Congress' Congressional Research Service.

In 1998, Sarita Brown asked Santiago to join her at the White House Initiative on Educational Excellence for Hispanic Americans as deputy director. There, Santiago worked with federal agencies and communities across the nation to improve awareness and educational opportunities for Latinos. In two years, Santiago led the production of 11 publications on key issues and educational status for Latinos from pre-K to graduate and professional levels and in the workforce. Santiago is the primary author of the Clinton/Riley Administration's culminating report, "Creating the Will: Hispanics Achieving Educational Excellence."

Santiago is the national expert on Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs) having tracked their emergence since inception in federal legislation. Using data to inform higher education and the public about the impact and potential for HSIs and all colleges and universities, she is a firm believer that data informs policy. She notes that it can't be data for data's sake — data must be used to improve student outcomes. In her work at *Excelecencia* in Education, Santiago applies data to inform institutions and promote thinking about Latinos in a constructive, asset-based way. She designed the new Seal of *Excelecencia* national certification that is transforming engaged colleges and universities. "Serving Latino students is about more than just enrolling them," she says. "It's about supporting their journey through college graduation and into the workforce."

STUDENT PINNACLE AWARDS

The Student Pinnacle Award is bestowed upon an outstanding student member of the graduating class. The student should meet the following criteria:

- Reflection of the unique character of FDU in his/her life;
- Significant contributions and outstanding service to the University;
- Significant contributions to society and humanity through public or humanitarian service;
- Cumulative grade point ratio of 3.00 or higher;
- Success or distinction in his/her chosen field of study; and
- Must be graduating in May 2023.

THE PRESIDENT

Michael J. Avaltroni was appointed interim president on January 1, 2023, and then named the ninth president in the institution's history on April 26. He is a 1999 graduate of Fairleigh Dickinson University, receiving a B.S. in chemistry, *summa cum laude*. He went on to complete an M.A. in chemistry in 2001 and a Ph.D. in chemistry in 2003, both from Princeton University. His research interest is in surface science, specifically focused on surface modification of titanium materials to facilitate cell attachment, biomineralization and interfacial adhesion in biomedical devices. His research in this area has led to multiple publications and 10 United States patents. In addition, the technology he has created in this field of study has been licensed for the creation of two biotechnology companies, Orthobond, Inc., Princeton, N.J., and Aculon, Inc., San Diego, Calif.

Since joining the University in 2003, Avaltroni has worked in a number of different capacities, including as a faculty member and chair of the department of chemistry and pharmaceutical sciences. He was instrumental in the process to create the School of Pharmacy and Health Sciences. In 2009, he began building the school's curriculum, experiential learning and programmatic infrastructure as associate dean for academic affairs. He took over as interim dean in 2012 and was appointed permanently to the position of dean in spring 2013. Since creating the blueprint for the school in 2009, he saw the program accept its first class, worked to put together a first-rate team of faculty and staff, built strong relationships with the pharmacy and health-care communities across the state and the region and moved the program through full accreditation status with the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE). He also led efforts to expand health-science offerings across the University through programs in public health, physician assistant studies, occupational therapy, physical therapy and social work.

Avaltroni was appointed University provost and senior vice president for academic affairs in January 2022. In this role, he led the academic affairs subcommittee of the Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Accessibility (DEIA) Advisory Council; laid the groundwork for new community-college partnerships; presided over the development of the Hispanic Center (which this year had two of its programs nationally recognized by *Excelencia* in Education); and coordinated the formation of a new academic leadership team. He further created the Transformational Excellence Awards to honor those faculty and staff who have gone beyond the ordinary to serve FDU students.

Since becoming president, Avaltroni has led many important initiatives including engaging the community in the strategic-planning process that led to the development of the plan titled "FDU Will Soar." Driving the planning process has been a renewed

emphasis on putting students first and on prioritizing those items and initiatives that will most significantly and positively impact students. FDU also successfully concluded the capital campaign "One University Many Dreams," which raised approximately \$90 million, easily surpassing its original goal of \$75 million. The University will soon introduce a new fundraising campaign focusing exclusively on raising money to help students have access to and better afford an FDU education.

In April, he was named to the ROI Influencers: Higher Education list for 2023. Each year, ROI-NJ highlights the presidents, deans and directors with the most significant influence and impact at their schools — and within the business community.

THE UNIVERSITY

Founded in 1942 by Dr. Peter Sammartino and his wife, Sylvia (Sally), Fairleigh Dickinson University has grown into the largest private university in New Jersey and offers more than 100 degree programs at the associate, baccalaureate, master's and doctoral levels. More than 11,000 students from 41 states and 74 other countries are enrolled on FDU's two campuses in New Jersey and its overseas campuses in Wroxton, England, and Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada.

Beginning as a two-year junior college in Rutherford to respond to the need for higher education in northern New Jersey, the college expanded to a four-year curricula in 1948. In 1954, Bergen Junior College in Teaneck was purchased as a second campus. In 1956, Fairleigh Dickinson attained university status. One year later, the Vanderbilt-Twombly estate in Florham Park and Madison, New Jersey, was acquired to serve as another campus.

FDU became the first American university to own a campus in England when it acquired Wroxton College from Trinity College, Oxford University. Opened in 1965, Wroxton College offers American students an array of graduate and undergraduate programs as well as an enriching cultural experience.

Over the years Fairleigh Dickinson University has maintained its commitment to broadening global horizons and fostering greater international understanding. In 2000, the Board of Trustees adopted a newly focused mission for FDU: "Fairleigh Dickinson University is a center of academic excellence dedicated to the preparation of world citizens through global education. The University strives to provide students with the multidisciplinary, intercultural and ethical understandings necessary to participate, lead and prosper in the global marketplace of ideas, commerce and culture." The University opened its second international campus in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada, in fall 2007.

Each University campus has developed a unique character and vitality. The Metropolitan Campus, located in Teaneck and Hackensack, features a university atmosphere with an international perspective attracting nearly equal numbers of graduate and undergraduate students from throughout the United States and around the world. The Florham Campus in suburban Madison and Florham Park offers a classical undergraduate and graduate experience for the contemporary world in a small college setting.

Fairleigh Dickinson University has enjoyed special partnerships with prominent institutions around the globe. For example, the University has been associated with the United Nations since it was founded in 1945 and has earned special designations with the world body that provide unique learning opportunities for students and faculty.

With the depth and breadth of its faculty and programs, Fairleigh Dickinson University has transformed the lives of its students and positioned itself as a quality, comprehensive private university serving the citizens of New Jersey and beyond.

INTERNATIONALLY DIVERSE

In addition to the United States and the U.S. island territories, Fairleigh Dickinson University students hail from a wide cross section of countries including Afghanistan, Albania, Argentina, Bangladesh, Barbados, Belgium, Belize, Bhutan, Brazil, Cambodia, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, Cyprus, Denmark, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Egypt, Estonia, France, Germany, Ghana, Honduras, Hungary, India, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Italy, Jamaica, Japan, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Kuwait, Latvia, Lithuania, Macedonia, Mexico, Moldova, Morocco, Myanmar, Nepal, Nigeria, Norway, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Portugal, Qatar, Romania, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Sri Lanka, Sudan, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, Thailand, Trinidad and Tobago, Turkey, Turkmenistan, Uganda, Ukraine, United Kingdom, Venezuela, Vietnam and Zimbabwe.

PILLAR SOCIETY

The Pillar Society was instituted to recognize those exceptional individuals who have made extraordinary contributions to the character and quality of the University, its community and culture. Criteria include serving FDU in a non-faculty role for at least 10 years on a level below the rank of vice president. Recipients are invited to participate in the Commencement ceremony procession.

THE ACADEMIC REGALIA

The academic regalia worn by University officials and faculty at today's Commencement ceremony are infrequently seen outside of formal academic occasions.

The gowns, caps and hoods once were the regular apparel of European university students and faculty during the Middle Ages.

At that time, both faculty and students were considered part of the clergy and were required to don the ecclesiastical dress, *roba* and *caputum*, patterned after the habit of the Benedictine Order.

The regalia also served a practical purpose, providing warmth in the unheated stone buildings of most medieval universities.

In the United States, caps and gowns had been in limited use by colleges and universities since Colonial times. It was not until a century later that a widespread student move-

ment resulted in the formal use of the attire at commencement ceremonies.

Faculty members readily accepted the return to a dignified and traditional dress for graduations and soon extended the custom to other formal academic functions.

By 1895, a uniform code for academic dress had been adopted in the United States, and although no formal worldwide standards have ever existed, certain basic and traditional elements are evident in most academic attire.

The Gowns

Participants in academic ceremonies are expected to wear the regalia to which they are entitled by virtue of the highest degree they hold.

Gowns worn by those with bachelor's degrees are distinguished by a semi-stiff yoke, long pleated front, intricate shirring across the shoulders and back and long pointed sleeves open at the wrists. The gown must be worn closed.

Master's degree holders wear a similar gown of either silk or wool with the same yoke effect as the bachelor's degree robe. The master's gown may be worn either open or closed in the front.

The doctor's gown, also worn either open or closed, is usually made of silk and velvet with full and round sleeves open at the wrists. These gowns are distinguished by long velvet panels down the front of the gown and three horizontal velvet sleeve bars, which may be either black or the color distinctive of the academic discipline in which the individual holds the doctoral degree.

Although the color of these gowns is traditionally black, some institutions have adopted robes in their school colors.

The Caps

The most familiar item of academic regalia is the Oxford or mortarboard cap with its distinctive tassel. Explanations of its origin include suggestions that its shape was inspired by the quadrangular Oxford campus or by the actual master workman's mortarboard. Perhaps a more plausible theory is that it was designed flat and about the size of a scholar's book for ease in carrying. Material for most caps varies from serge and broadcloth to rayon and silk, although caps worn by doctoral degree recipients may be of velvet.

The most distinctive feature of the cap is the tassel, which is positioned to hang from the left front quadrant of the cap. The tassel is black for bachelor's and master's degree holders, but gold for Ph.D.s and the primary governing officials of an institution. While the mortarboard cap is used by the vast majority of institutions around the world, some schools have adopted a soft, square-topped cap, but still retain the tassel.

The Hoods

The most distinctive feature of academic attire, the hood lends color and definition to academic ceremonies. Once used as a head covering, a shoulder cape and even a receptacle for collecting alms in medieval times, the hood is now a purely ceremonial black shell of varying sizes and colored borders suspended from the shoulders and worn down the back.

The significance of academic hoods is symbolized in their varying lengths and the colors and thicknesses of their velvet linings and trim. The bachelor's hood, for example, is three feet long with a two-inch-wide velvet border. Master's degree recipients wear a hood three-and-a-half feet long with a three-inch border. Doctoral hoods are four feet long and have a five-inch-wide border.

More distinctive, however, are the colors of the hoods' inner linings and outer trim. The colors of the inner lining correspond to the colors of the institution conferring the degree, while the colors of the border designate the academic discipline in which the degree was granted.

THE MACE

The mace, a traditional symbol of authority, is carried in the academic procession by the grand marshal. The Fairleigh Dickinson University mace was presented to the University in 1957 by Mr. and Mrs. Leo Pollak of New York City. It is one of only three maces of its type in the United States and was purchased for the University from Seymour B. Wyler, author of *The Book of Sheffield Plate* and *The Book of Old Silver*.

A very rare example of 18th-century Sheffield plate, it was made in 1765 for the Riddell family and bears its crest. A member of that family was an English representative to the Holland town of Duysberg.

THE PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

Along with the traditional academic regalia and trappings common to colleges and universities throughout the United States, most institutions also possess some unique or distinctive symbol of the presidential office that is conveyed through succeeding administrations. Fairleigh Dickinson University commissioned the design and crafting of a President's Medallion for the inauguration of Robert H. Donaldson on March 29, 1985.

The President's Medallion is in the form of a hexagonal shield, a variation of the University "Shield of Arms." In the center of the Medallion is the gold-plated coat of arms. The motto, *Fortiter et Suaviter* (Bravely and Pleasurably), is engraved above the shield, and around it are engraved the words "Fairleigh Dickinson University 1942." The gold-plated frame of the Medallion is surmounted by a crest consisting of buildings symbolizing the campuses.

Kurt J. Matzdorf, professor emeritus of gold and silver-smithing at the State University of New York, College at New Paltz, and internationally known for his ceremonial and religious silver, designed and created the President's Medallion.
