Frequently Asked Questions for Parents

Who does my student email about their course schedule?

Your student can email <u>metroadvisementscheduling@fdu.edu</u> for more information on their course schedule. Please have the student keep an eye on their FDU email in the coming weeks for their schedule.

How does my student get their FDU ID and parking decal?

Your student can contact Director of Public Safety, David Miles, at 201-692-2222 or dmiles@fdu.edu for more information on receiving their student ID and/or parking decal. The student should email the picture they would like to use for their ID to dmiles@fdu.edu. If your student is a commuter, the ID will be mailed to their home address. If the student is a resident, they will receive an ID when moving in. Your student can get more than one parking decal should they have more than 1 vehicle.

What happens if my student loses their ID?

Contact Public Safety at 201-692-2222 and they will make the student a new one. There is a \$25.00 fine to replace cards.

Who does my student send their final transcript to?
