## ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

This teacher training scholarship covers the cost of 12 graduate credits for four courses in the Orton Gillingham approach. These courses form the core of FDU's nationally accredited Orton Gillingham Dyslexia Specialist Training Program. Credits earned also can be applied toward select graduate degrees in FDU's School of Education.

Orton Gillingham training prepares teachers to better support struggling readers – including students with dyslexia.

### About the Scholarship Program

Scholarship recipients attend lecture sessions and engage in supervised practicum experiences at one of these five Children's Dyslexia Centers of New Jersey locations:

- Hasbrouck Heights
- Burlington/Trenton
- Tenafly
- Northfield
- Scotch Plains

Practicum sessions meet twice each week for approximately 15 weeks each semester. It takes four semesters (two academic years) to complete the program. During each practicum session, teachers use the Orton Gillingham approach to instruct children with dyslexia.
