Impact on Learning and Teacher Effectiveness

CAEP Measure 1: This impact and effectiveness data comes from the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) Education Preparation Provider Annual Report, released Fall 2024. This data is for FDU program completers who graduated during the 2020-21 school year who were employed in NJ public schools during the 2022-23 school year.

Evaluation Score Type	% Scoring Effective or Highly Effective
Summative Score: based on multiple measures of student achievement and teacher practice. This varies by grade and subject taught	100%
Teacher Practice Score: measured through classroom observations and pre/post-conferences	100%
Teacher Growth Objective Score: combined score as assessed by the district's evaluation system for assigning teacher performance ratings	100%

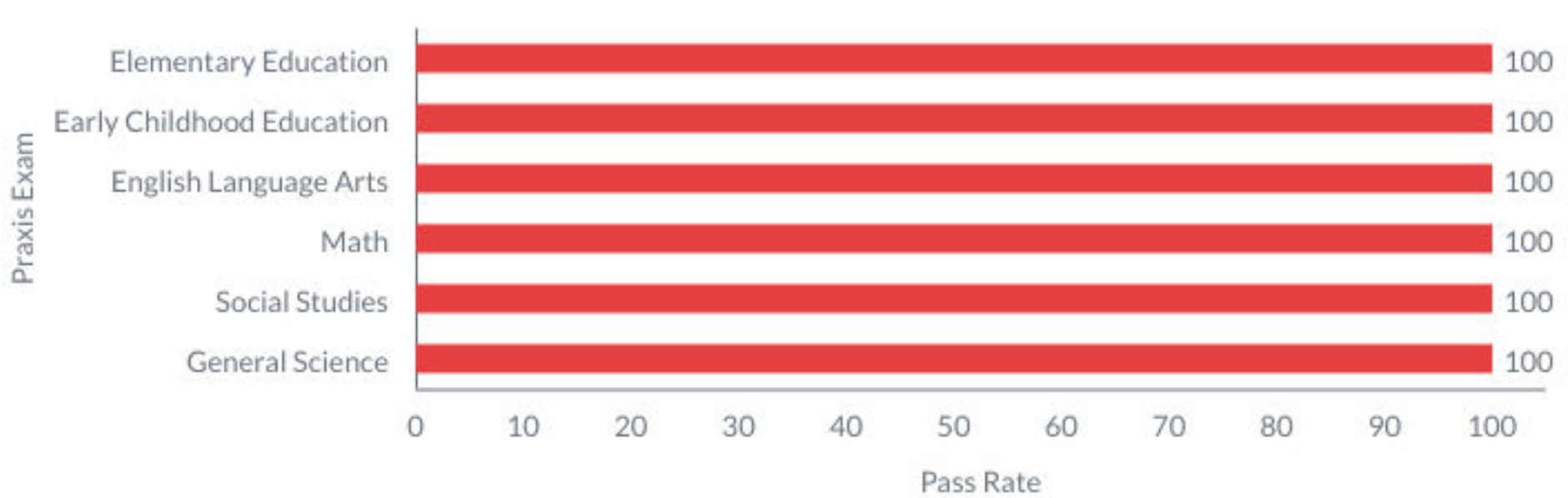
