



SCIENCV REQUIRED FOR CREATION OF BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH AND CURRENT AND PENDING SUPPORT DOCUMENTS

The National Science Foundation (NSF) and the National Institutes of Health (NIH) now require the use of SciENcv (Science Experts Network Curriculum Vitae) for the preparation of the biographical sketch and current and pending support document.

Science Experts Network Curriculum Vitae (SciENcv) is an electronic system that helps researchers assemble multiple formats of biographical sketch and current and pending support documents needed for participation in federally funded research.

HOW CAN I CREATE A SCIENCV PROFILE?

SciENcv is part of the My NCBI suite of tools. Anyone may create a My NCBI account using the instructions at <http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/books/NBK154494/>.
